## Settings

On first set-up, you will be asked for the following details:

**Username** – User ID for the device.

**Web Services URL** – The webservice URL required to connect to MACE.

**Timeout (seconds)** – The delay that will occur before an error is displayed while trying to connect to MACE.

Press **Save** and then complete the additional settings:

**App ID** – This will be generated automatically

**Company** – The company to connect to in MACE

**Branch** – The branch to raise mobile orders for

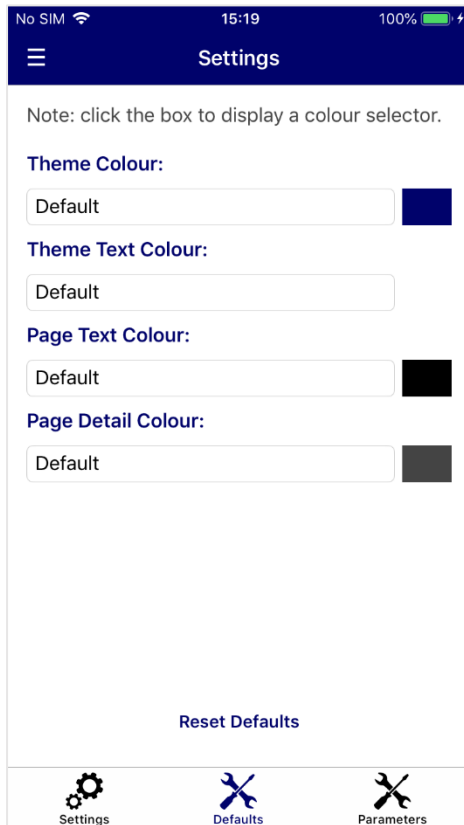
Additional options include:

**Test Web Services** – Test the device connection to web services

**Test Mace Connection** – Test the device connection to MACE

**Wipe App** – Clear device data and restore to default settings

## Defaults



The Defaults page can be used to change application colours.

**Theme Colour** – Main colour for the application

**Theme Text Colour** – Used for text headings and titles

**Page Text Colour** – Application Background colour

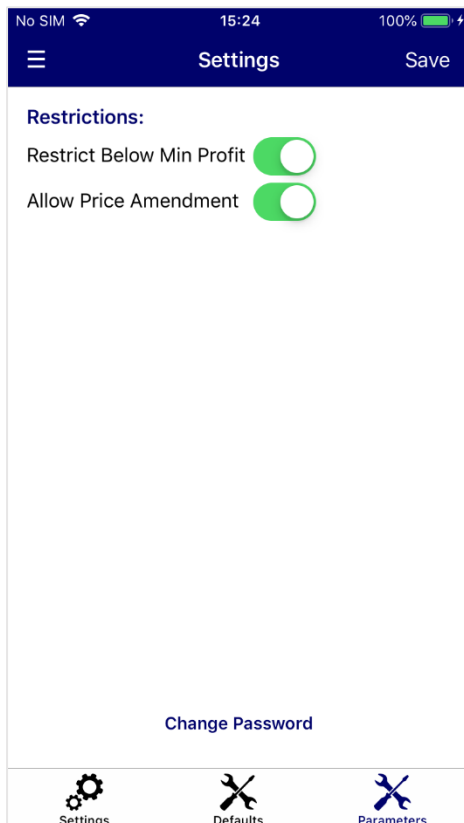
**Page Detail Colour** – Used for page text

**Reset Defaults** – Set colours to the default application colour scheme

There are multiple colour options, with the ability to enter colour names such as ‘red’, or type in a colour’s hexadecimal code. Colours on this screen will be saved automatically.

Alternatively, clicking the box next to the textbox will open a detailed colour selection screen. Click **Save** on this screen to save your colour selection.

## Parameters



The settings in this page are application global.

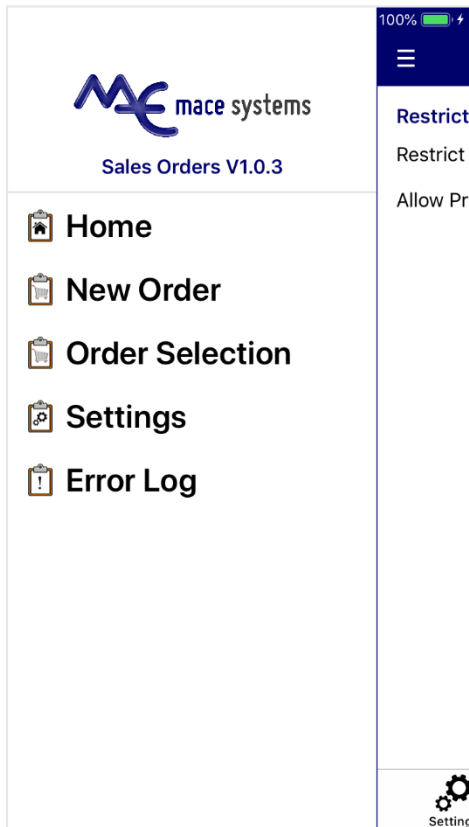
**Restrict Below Min Profit** – Restrict the order to minimum profit values

**Allow Price Amendment** – Allow user to change prices within the application

**Change Password** – Set a password to access this page and change parameter settings.

**Save** – Save any changes made to the parameters

### Navigation



To navigate, either slide the screen to the right, or press the three dashed lines.

To select a page, tap on the required menu option.

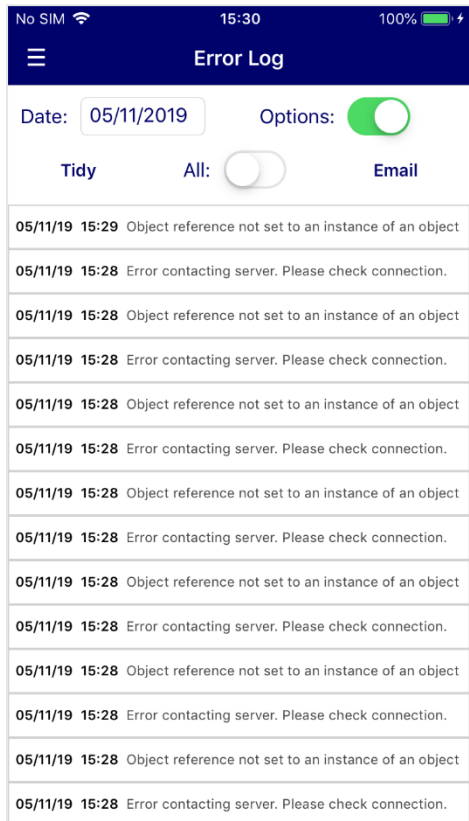
To create a new mobile order, tap **New Order**.

To select an existing mobile order, tap **Order Selection**.

To change settings, select the **Settings** option.

To view past error messages, tap **Error Log**.

### Error Log



**Date** – List error messages on a set date

**Options** – Display options bar

**Tidy** – Clear error messages older than 60 days old

**All** – View all messages regardless of set date

**Email** – Email error log to MACE Support

## Order Entry

**Order** – The order ID. This will be generated when the order is saved

**Order Ref** – Customer order reference

**Customer** – The customer ID. Customers can be selected by ID, name and sort key

**Salesman** – Salesman ID. This is populated automatically by the customer default but can be changed

**FRE** – Add a line of text to the order

**Add** – Add a product to the order. Products can be searched for by ID, name and sort key, with their default price pulled in automatically. Product quantity can be adjusted with the -/+ buttons. Slide line to the right to delete the product or tap the product line to display the Product page.

**Total** – Total value of order

**Options** – Save the order or delete the order and return to the home screen

**Description** – Product description

**Quantity** – Adjust the line product quantity

**Price Per 1** - Price value for a single unit

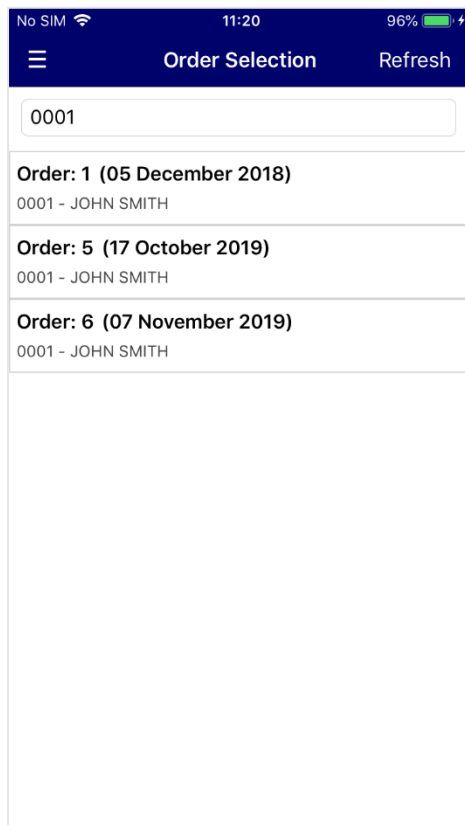
**Discount** – Total product line discount

**Total** – Total goods value for this line

**Save** – Save the pricing amendments

The Product page also displays the current stock balances for the product.

## Mobile Order Selection

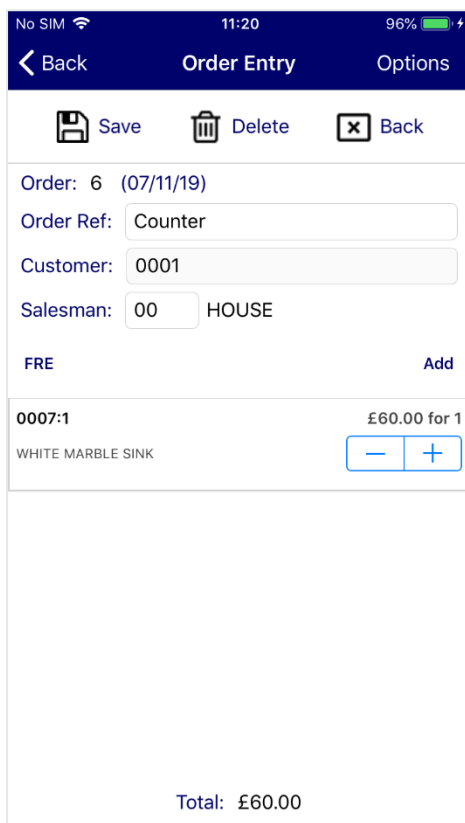


**Customer ID** - Search for orders by customer ID

**Refresh** - Refresh the list of orders

Tap an order to display the order details within the Order Entry page

## Order Entry – Existing Orders



Existing orders opened through Order Selection will have additional features under the **Options** button.

**Save** – Save the changes to the order

**Delete** – Delete the order

**Back** – Return to the Home page

### Counter Order Entry

At the Order Number field in Counter Order Entry, type 'M'. A list of mobile orders will be displayed, which can be selected to convert to a MACE sales order.



## Unlock Mobile Orders

If a mobile order is locked by the system but not currently in use on a device, the order can be unlocked through the Unlock Mobile Orders process. This can be found under the **Other | System Security** menu options.

At the Order ID prompt, enter the mobile order ID or press '#' to display a list of locked mobile orders. When an order is selected, hit 'Y' to unlock the order.




